

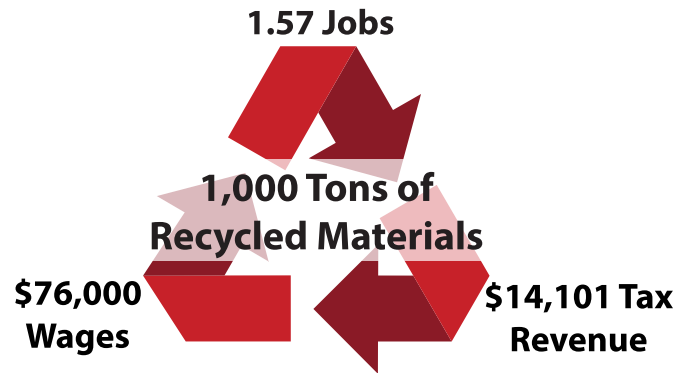

Recycling Creates U.S. Jobs

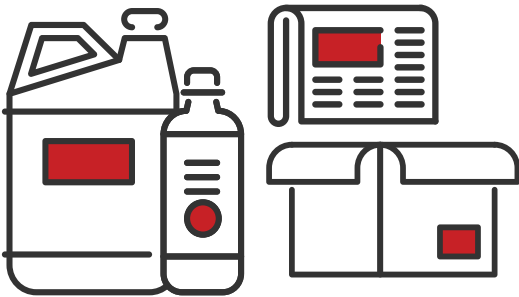
In one year, recycling and reuse in the United States accounted for:

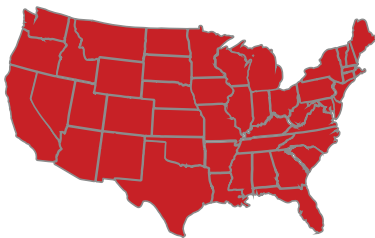


What America Needs Now
